

If-clauses Typ 1

(Bedingungssätze Typ 1)


Die Bedingungssätze haben im Englischen zwei Teile:

- den *if-Satz*, der die Bedingung angibt und
- den Hauptsatz, der besagt, was passieren wird, wenn die Bedingung erfüllt wird.

Type 1

If the weather is fine, we will go for a walk.

↓ ↓
Simple Present Will future

 No will
in the if-part of the
sentence!!!!
